The Alpha Fire Company consists of Firefighters and Fire Police. To become a member of the Company in either role you MUST meet all of the following criteria:

- Possess a current, valid United States driver's license.
- No record of arrest and/or conviction in prior 5 years
- No felony convictions.
- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Must have a high school diploma, G.E.D., or recognized equivalent.
- Have residency status (Type 1 Membership) within the Centre Region as follows:
 - Resident of State College Borough or the Townships of College, Ferguson, or Patton
 - Non-resident Penn State students must be enrolled at the University Park Campus
- Have previous fire service training/certification (Type 2 and Type 3 Membership)
 - Firefighter 1 (ProBoard or recognized equivalent)
 - Current certificate: First Aid, CPR/AED, and Hazardous Materials Operations
 - Have completed at least TWO approved, documented ride alongs (Type 2)
- All applicants, regardless of membership type, must complete a Company interview, and a pretraining physical.

Notes:

- Penn State Students must be able to serve a minimum of two years at the time of their Company interview.
- The Company interview team will assess a candidate's ability to provide beneficial service to the Company.
- The Company pays the cost of the physical exam. There is no out-of-pocket expense to the candidate.

The Alpha Volunteer Fire Company is made up of all of the above and more — selfless, motivated members of the Centre Region community who choose to do more, and be more, as Alpha Volunteer Firefighters or Fire Police Officers. Here are the basic requirements for membership:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Must have a high school diploma, G.E.D., or recognized equivalent
- Possess a current, valid United States issued driver's license
- Complete an application and background check
- Complete a pre-training physical (all costs covered by the Firemen's Relief Association of State College).

A Captain and three lieutenants lead the Alpha Fire Police. These officers are responsible for Fire Police Command Operations at scenes and for ensuring that all fire police earn the necessary certifications and are properly trained in traffic control as well as some exterior fire ground operations.

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

The Alpha Fire Police serve an important role within the fire company. They supplement local police officers when coming to the scene of an emergency. They:

- are among the faces of the Alpha Fire Company. When a resident arrives on the scene in a panic as their home and belongings are being destroyed by flames, we are the compassionate, initial contact that directs them into the scene safely.
- direct motorists around the scene of an accident or explain to them the reason for the delay. As best as we can, we provide information on alternate routes, recognizing that many people do not respond well to a change in their plans.
- assist local and state police with road closures, traffic control, crowd control, missing person searches, parade details, salvage, security, and other tasks as requested.
- provide traffic control and scene safety for our apparatus, firefighters and the public, assist with exterior fire operations as needed, and support the Fire Marshal's investigations.

Within 24 months of joining, you will attend and successfully complete courses in Basic Fire Police, Advanced Fire Police, Hazmat Operations, Emergency Vehicle Driver Training (EVDT), Fire Hydrant Operations, Bloodborne Pathogens, First Aid and CPR/AED. New members are introduced to the company and its operations by completing our Fire Police Pre-Emergency Response Training (PERT) program. In this program, you'll learn the basic structure of the Alpha Fire Company and the structure and role of the Fire Police. Additionally, you'll be prepared for state level training courses. Beyond initial training, members must meet modest annual training requirements from a combination of in-house and outside training.

Upon completion of our Fire Police PERT program, you'll be assigned to a Field Training Officer. You will be introduced to all of the duties of the Fire Police in order to become a fully functioning team member who is capable of independently serving as a Fire Police Officer.

Membership Requirements



The Alpha Fire Company requires a minimum level of participation each year by its members. Members who fail to accumulate the specified minimum points may lose their standing in the company.

Firefighter – Active Type 1:

- 1. Annual Training:
 - a. Permanent Members: 30 hours minimum.
 - b. Probationary Members: Completion of the Alpha Fire Company in-house probationary training program in the first 12 months (PERT, approximately 60-70 hours). Within 24 months of joining the Company, members must attain PA Certification as a Firefighter 1, complete Hazardous Materials Operations Level training, CPR, and Basic First Aid.
- 2. Physicals (must pass):
 - a. Permanent Members: Company paid bi-annual physical.
 - b. Probationary Members: Company-paid pre-training physical before starting PERT.
- 3. Meetings: Attend a minimum of 4 regular meetings per year. (There are 14 per year.)
- 4. Response to Incidents/Standbys: Accumulate at least 200 points for response to incidents, bunk-in, and/or standbys. (1 point awarded for each incident response, 5 points for every 12-hour standby)

Fire Police Officer – Active Type 1:

- 1. Annual Training:
 - a. Permanent Members: 30 hours minimum.
 - b. Probationary Members: Completion of the Alpha Fire Company in-house probationary training program in the first 12 months (Fire Police PERT, approximately 40 hours). Within 24 months of joining the Company, the member must attain certification in Basic and Advanced Fire Police, complete Hazardous Materials Operations Level training (preferred) or Hazmat Awareness, EVDT (Emergency Vehicle Driver Training), CPR/AED and Basic First Aid, ICS 100 (Introduction to Incident Command System), IS 200 (Basic Incident Command System for Initial Response), and ICS 700 (Introduction National Incident Management System NIMS).
- 2. Physicals (must pass):
 - a. Permanent Members: Company paid bi-annual physical.
 - b. Probationary Members: Company paid pre-training physical before starting PERT.
- 3. Meetings: Attend a minimum of 4 regular meetings per year. (There are 14 per year.)
- 4. Response to Incidents/Standbys: Accumulate at least 200 points for response to incidents, bunk-in, and/or standbys. (1 point awarded for each incident response, 5 points for every 12-hour standby)

Firefighter – Active Type 2 (Must Have Firefighter 1 Certification ProBoard, Current Hazmat Ops, Current First Aid/CPR/AED)

- 1. Annual Training:
 - a. Permanent Members: 30 hours minimum.
 - b. Probationary Members: Completion of the Alpha in-house probationary training program in the first 12 months (PERT, approximately 60-70 hours).
- 2. Physicals (must pass):
 - a. Permanent Members: Company paid bi-annual physical.
 - b. Probationary Members: Company paid pre-training physical before starting PERT.
- 3. Standbys: 180 shift points per year, which is equal to 432 standby hours, with a minimum shift length of 8-hours.

Firefighter – Active Type 3 Live-In Members (Must have Firefighter 1 ProBoard Certification):

- 1. Annual Training:
 - a. Permanent Members: 30 hours minimum.
 - Probationary Members: Completion of the Alpha in-house probationary training program in the first 12 months (PERT, approximately 60-70 hours), First Aid, CPR/AED, and Hazardous Materials Operations
- 2. Physicals (must pass):
 - a. Permanent Members: Company paid bi-annual physical.
 - b. Probationary Members: Company paid pre-training physical before starting PERT.
- 3. Annual Standby Hours:
 - a. Must staff 72 weekday hours and 48 weekend hours **per quarter** as assigned by the Chief and Company President.

> Training:

Upon completion of the probationary member training requirements specified above, every active member shall, during each subsequent year, diligently participate in training on approved firefighting or emergency techniques. Every member shall participate in at least 30 hours of approved training each year to meet the minimum requirements for membership. Of the 30 hours, 15 must be from in-house, company-wide training. This does not include certification/recertification classes offered by the Alpha Fire Company. The fire chief will designate certain requirements that must be maintained by active members. These will be announced by the fire chief, and members are given an appropriate amount of time to achieve successful completion. Examples of annual requirements: Hazmat Operations Level, Blood Borne Pathogens, and CPR/AED.

- Annual Attendance and Points Requirements (please reference Membership Policy for additional, detailed information):
 - 1. General Membership:
 - a. Incidents and Shifts 200 total points (Type 1); 180 shift only points (Type 2)
 - b. Incidents one point per incident
 - c. Shifts Five points per twelve-hour shift (Type I members must complete at least one four- hour shift per month to receive shift points; only shifts of 8 hours or longer will count toward points for Type 2 members)
- Attend at least 4 company meetings during the year. Meetings are the first Tuesday of each month beginning at 7 p.m. There are a total of 14 meetings each year. This includes an extra meeting on the third Tuesday of the month in May and December. (required for Type 1 members)
- ➤ "Beards and facial hair that interferes with the face piece seal are prohibited for all members required to use respiratory protection equipment; this includes long sideburns, goatees, mustaches that extend down beyond the chin, etc. If eyeglasses are worn, the member shall use frames that do not pass through the seal area of the face piece; corrective lens kits are available to any member that needs them through the Firemen's Relief Association of State College."
